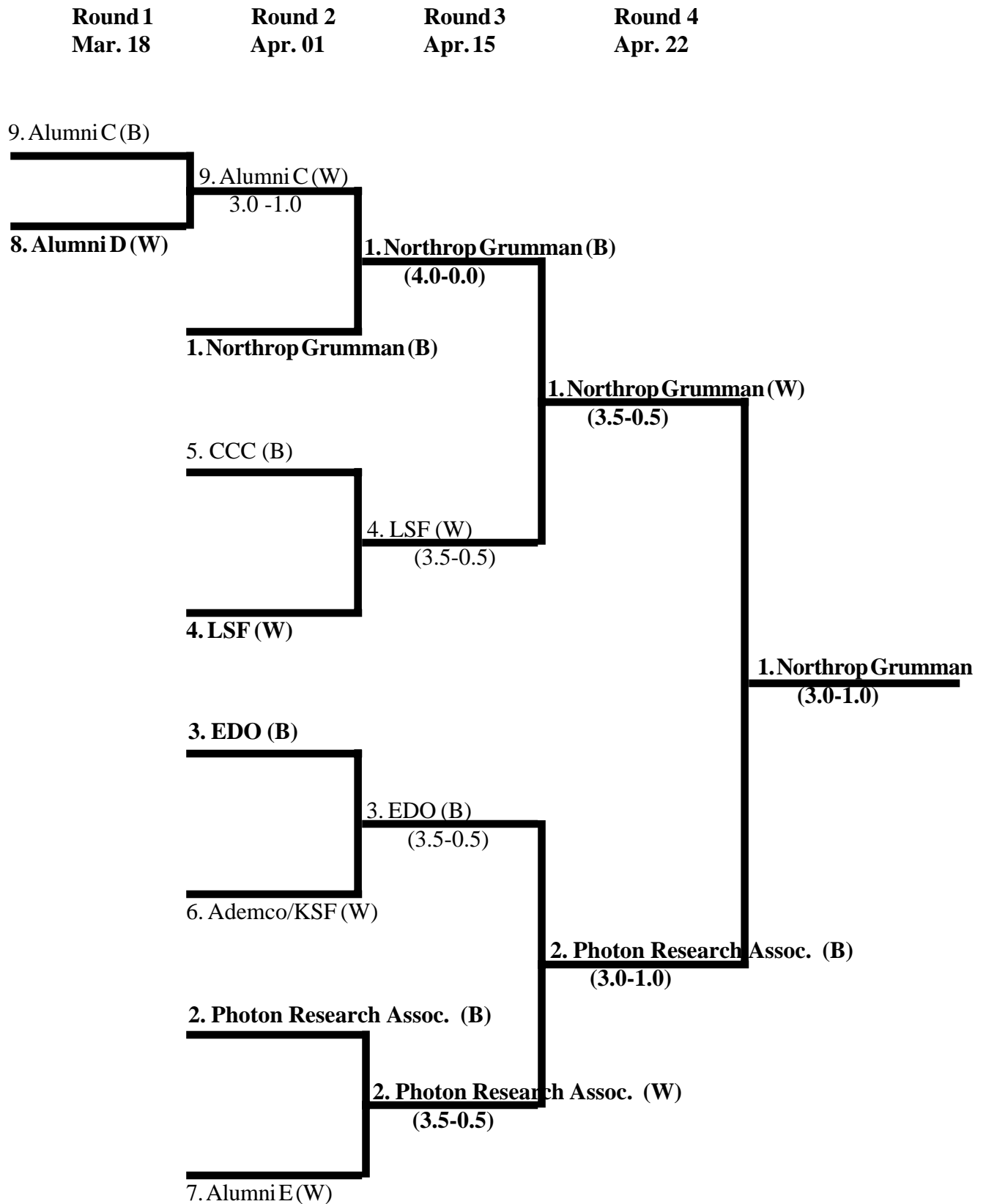

1) Motion: "To waive all forfeiture fees resulting from a scheduled Wednesday" Passed 5 for, 0 against, 0 abstain

2) Motion: "To name Jim Dwulit "Rules Director" to complete the term of Alan Benjamin" Passed 5 for, 0 against, 0 abstain

3) Treasurer's Report: An additional \$65 was collected for the Alan Benjamin tribute. The total individual contributions came to \$215. The LIICL has added another \$100 from the Treasury. \$250 was sent to the NYS Chess Association on behalf of Alan on February 2, 2001. This was sent along with a letter from the LIICL. A copy of the letter was distributed at this meeting and is available to any league member wishing to view it. An additional contribution to the NYSCA will be made in the amount of \$65.

4) The current (Jan. 31, 2001) balance in the LIICL Treasury is \$1,754.58 which includes both checking and money market. Outstanding current obligations include the \$100 for the Benjamin tribute and approximately \$200 owed for refreshments. This leaves a net of approximately \$1,450.00. There is another obligation for \$50 which is for the Rothman trophy to be equally funded by the LIICL and the CCLNY. This trophy will be the cup that we play for in the next All Star match. The LIICL has petitioned the CCLNY to have the name on the cup changed to the "Rothman-Benjamin" trophy. There is one long term credit due the LIICL which is represented by the \$50 deposit given to the Congregational Church of Huntington.

5) An insurance quote was quoted to the LIICL by the Jack Morejon Agency, 66 Guy Lombardo Ave., Freeport, NY. Liability insurance is now a prerequisite to playing in the Congregational Church and to other non-public sites. For \$1M coverage, \$3M aggregate with \$5,000 fire insurance, the annual premium would be \$1,240. Jim Dwulit had suggested that this could be split across this season and next to ease the financial burden.

Motion: "Table the liability insurance until all other possibilities are exhausted which would not require such an expense." Passed 7 for, 0 against, 0 abstain

6) In order to assist in individuals making up games that could not be completed during a Wednesday evening, it was suggested that a full directory be distributed.

Motion: "Captains shall provide a list of all individual members phone numbers and email addresses where voluntary on each individual's part. These would be given to the LIICL Treasurer for compilation and distribution of a complete listing to each LIICL member." Passed 8 for, 0 against, 0 abstain

7) Motion: "Remove Round 12 from the current season. Bob Rizzo reported that The Congregational Church of Huntington has verbally told us that only one Friday per month is available to the LIICL. At least one more site is needed as this does not meet our needs of bi-monthly meetings.

Steven and Zack Solomon were introduced to the LIICL. They had emailed the website expressing a desire to enter our league. They were informed that they could do it in two ways. Either they could form a team from their business, "King Solomon's Mines", or they could join with another organization under the conglomerate rule. Tom Ogen expressed a need for more players and it appeared that an agreement was reached whereby they would conglomerate with Ademco for the 2001-2002 season.

By random chance, Photon has the bye in Round 1. A schedule will be issued in the next few days and will be posted on the LIICL website.

The meeting was called to order at 12:05 PM

1) It was determined that the same 9 teams will be entering the league for the 2002-2003 season as last season. Numbers were selected at random by each team. For the 2002-2003 season the following team numbers were assigned: 1-LSF, 2-Alumni C, 3-Veeco, 4-Northrop Grumman, 5-Photon Research, 6-EDO, 7-Clear-Cut, 8-Alumni D, 9-Ademco.

2) It was reported by Bob Rizzo that there is \$1,212.00 in the treasury with an upcoming payment of \$48.00 due to renew the domain name liicl.com.

3) The issue of dues was brought up for discussion. The \$50 per team to subsidize a simul was dropped due to the fact that some teams felt they were subsidizing others. The fact that we could not commercialize the simul under Library Rules meant that an operating loss was a certainty. It was noted that not all costs were charged to the LIICL last season such as refreshment and supplies. 4) Photon raised a motion to switch the LIICL from game point standings to match point standings. The pros and cons of each scoring system was discussed especially noted was the possible conflicts between individual races and team races. The motion was defeated 2-7 with no abstentions.

5) The schedule was the final issue. Round one will be September 13th starting at 6:50 PM. With 9 teams a single round robin means only 8 matches. It was thought a double-round robin was too long a season by some. Mike Anthony indicated that since we would complete round 10 before the new year with the dates we had for 2002, that an 18-round regular season was not impossible but would require us playing through June. A motion was brought up to stay with the 12-round, 10 match season, identical to last season. The motion passed 7-1 with one abstention.

6) Some discussion was made to possibly merge the two Alumni teams thus eliminating the need for the bye round. It was also noted that it was possible that a tenth team might join which could also get rid of the bye problem. New teams can be absorbed until week two, September 27th. After that date a major schedule change would be needed.

Continue East on Jericho Turnpike to Larkfield Road then turn left. Proceed North approximately 3 miles, crossing Pulaski Road - East Northport Public Library is first building on right next to the park.

# REGULATIONS FOR USE OF NORTHPORT-EAST NORTHPORT PUBLIC LIBRARY MEETING ROOMS

dated 7/99

1. Subject to the rules and regulations set forth below, the Meeting Rooms of the Northport-East Northport Public Library located at 151 Laurel Avenue, Northport, and 185 Larkfield Road, East Northport, shall be available to individuals and groups for meetings or presentation of programs, ideas, topics, issues or entertainment which serve or advance the Library's purpose of encouraging the free and open exchange of ideas and expression of thought and creativity.
2. The primary purpose of the Library's meeting rooms is to serve as a venue for Library sponsored services, programs, and activities. Library services, programs and activities shall have priority over all other activities. The Library reserves the right to revoke a meeting room use permit or to reschedule a meeting should there be a conflict with Library related services, programs or activities; or in the case of an emergency.
3. Application to use the Library's meeting rooms must be made in writing by an adult on the form provided for this purpose at least two weeks in advance of the intended use. The meeting room application form must be signed by a library district resident. No application shall be considered officially approved until it is signed by the Library Director, or other person designated by the Board of Trustees, and returned to the applicant.
4. By executing the application, the applicant agrees to the release of the applicant's name and telephone number to any person requesting information concerning an organization's activities or programs.
5. Due to the limitations of the facility, use of the meeting rooms is restricted to district residents only.
6. The applicant must certify that the meeting rooms shall be used only for the specific activity stated on the application and for no other purpose whatsoever. No activity may disrupt Library operations.
7. The meeting rooms shall be used for non-profit purposes and shall not be used for conducting business or commercial transactions or for the personal profit of the applicant.
8. The meeting rooms are available only during hours when the library is open to the public. Library sponsored programs and activities take precedence in assignment of the meeting rooms, and may supersede any program scheduled.
9. Use of Library facilities does not imply endorsement of the beliefs or program of an organization by the Library or anyone connected with the Library. All publicity and/or media coverage for events in the Library,

whatever the source, must be submitted to the Community Services Librarian for authorization prior to issuance or coverage. The Library may only be mentioned as a location, not as the sponsor or an event nor as the headquarters of an organization, in all announcements or publicity relating to a meeting room event. The Library's telephone number may not be given to obtain further information regarding a non-library sponsored event. Any literature or other items to be distributed at a meeting must be submitted to the Community Services Librarian at least 48 hours prior to intended distribution. If items intended for distribution are in violation of law or regulations, distribution of same is prohibited.

10. The responsibility for the maintenance of public order and safety at a meeting is that of the applicant. Adequate responsible adult supervision shall be provided by the applicant. Groups whose membership includes minors must be supervised by responsible adults.

11. The Library Director, or designee, is authorized to order the termination of any meeting or activity making use of Library facilities in violation of any law or regulation. The determination by said Library official is final. The Library Director, or designated representative, is authorized to call upon appropriate security personnel or law enforcement agency to enforce such action if, in the opinion of the Library official, circumstances warrant such an action. Further permission to use the meeting room may be denied to any group which proves to be disorderly or which violates any law or regulation.

12. Smoking is not permitted.

13. The Library does not grant permission for the use of Library-owned media equipment by any community group using the meeting rooms. Any such equipment must be supplied by the community group.

14. No admissions fees may be charged; no donations may be solicited or accepted; nor may any items be sold. Use of the facilities will not be granted for fund raising purposes, except as may be permissible under law and with the explicit consent of the Library Board of Trustee. Such permission shall be deemed extraordinary.

15. The Library is not responsible for the safeguarding of any supplies, equipment, or other items owned by the applicant or by persons attending the applicant's activity. The Library will not store materials for any applicant. Items left in the Library will be considered abandoned property and will be disposed of in accordance with standard practice.

16. People attending functions are restricted to the designated meeting room and other public areas.

17. There will be no charge for use of the meeting rooms during the Library's regular hours of opening. Extended use after the Library's normal hours of operation may be requested in advance by the applicant. Should such permission be granted, the applicant will incur a charge of \$15 for each hour, or fraction thereof, that the applicant intends to use the meeting room. Under no circumstances will use be approved beyond two hours after the Library's regular closing hour. Checks payable to the Library for this purpose must accompany the application. No refunds will be made except in the event of cancellation of the activity by the Library or cancellation of the activity by the applicant at least 48 hours prior to the scheduled activity.

18. The meeting rooms must be left in a neat and orderly condition. If not, a written notice will be given to the group that a second offense will result in its being denied further use of the meeting rooms.

19. The service of light refreshments is permitted, provided the kitchen unit is cleaned by the applicant. Prior approval must be given. Alcoholic beverages are specifically prohibited.
20. The meeting rooms are not intended for parties and/or celebrations.
21. Personal Liability - Whenever library buildings are used there is the possibility that persons may be injured and may bring legal action against the Library Board of Trustees and/or the contracting organization for personal liability. The Library Board of Trustees carries a public liability insurance policy to protect the library in case legal action is brought by any person injured on Library property. It is possible that organizations using the property may be sued for personal injury. Each organization should, therefore, protect itself by having a temporary insurance policy protecting it against such legal action. The signature on the bottom of the application is acknowledgment by the organization that it recognizes this responsibility.
22. Indemnification - By execution of the meeting room application, the applicant hereby indemnifies the Northport-East Northport Public Library and its Board of Trustees and employees from any liability or claim arising from the applicant's use of the meeting rooms, and agrees to hold the library, its Board of Trustees, and employees harmless from any claim, lawsuit, or liability which arises from such use, including but not limited to, any attorney's fees, costs, or expenses incurred by the library in connection with defending any claim arising from the applicant's use.
23. The Library Board of Trustees may deny permission to use the Library meeting rooms to any group that proves disorderly or that violates these regulations.
24. Additional stipulations may be imposed by the Library, as may be deemed necessary.
25. Final decision on the use of the meeting rooms shall be made by the Library Board of Trustees. The final and sole interpretation of this policy rests with the Library's Board of Trustees. Implementation and enforcement are delegated to the Library Director.
