### Ten Teams to Start Season

The return of the LIRR means that there will be no byes this season, unless, of course, if a new team enters at the last minute. The LIRR team "retired" after the 2003-2004 season upon winning the LIICL championship. They have been immediately installed as the favorite this season as their first three boards from that championship team are back. The nine other teams are all returning from last season albeit with some player changes.

Among these changes are Adrian Celaru taking over as captain of Alumni E (Red Bilkis is now a resident of NYC) and the familiar "Ademco" name is gone having been replaced by their parent organization, "Honeywell". They are now "Honeywell/KSF." Tom Ogen remains at the helm.

The 10 teams will play a round-robin schedule with an additional 3 position rounds for a total of 12 regular season matches without byes. The current LIICL Schedule (Rev. A) can be found on page 10 of this issue. However, should an 11th team join at the last minute, we would revert to a round-robin with each team playing 10 matches and getting one bye in an 11-round season.

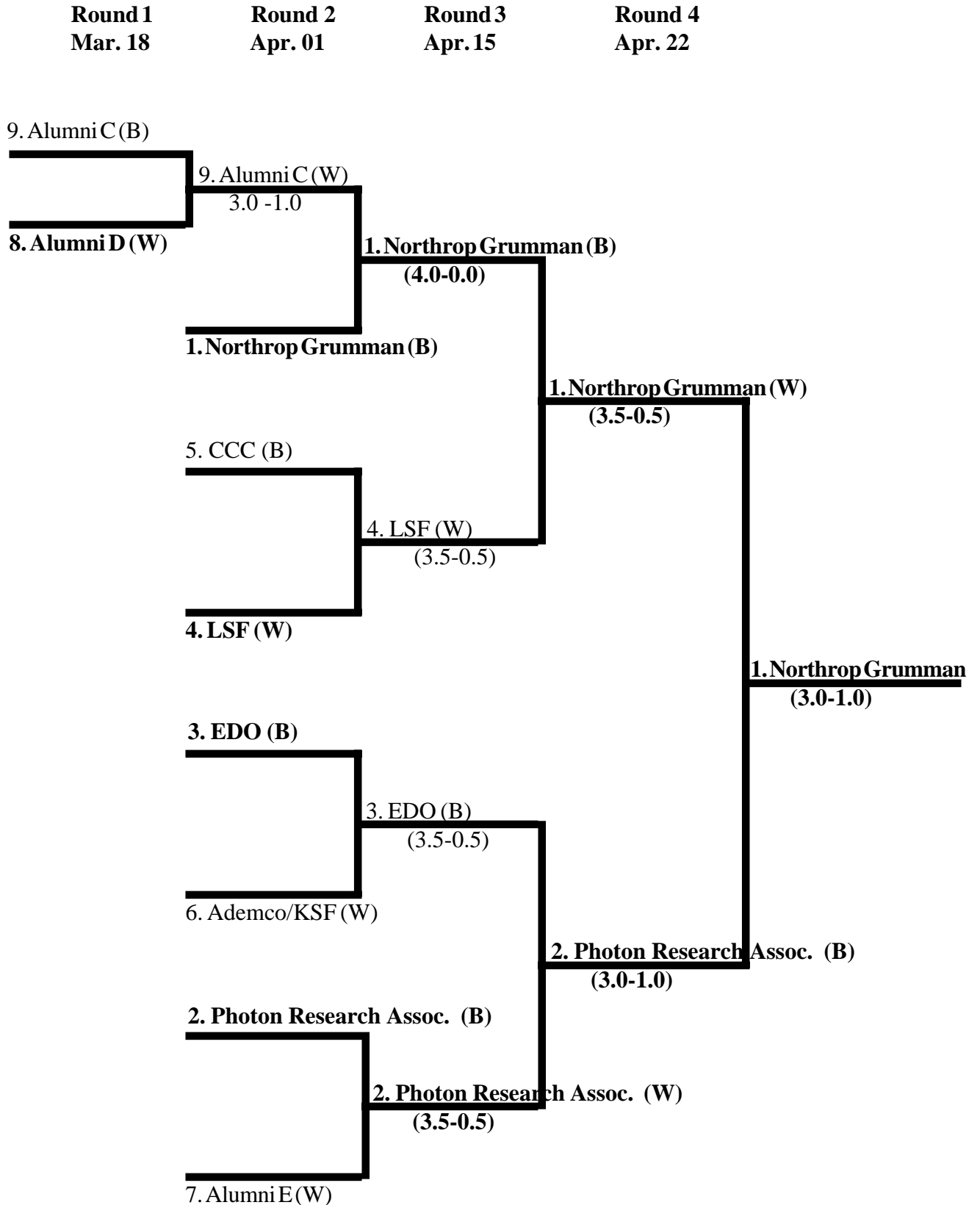
