Position Matches Affected by TBs

Round Five is the first of three position rounds in the LIICL regular season. As the standings below indicate, PRA and CCC both have 56 LIICL points, fourth best at this point in the season. For Round Five team 1 plays 2, 3 plays 4, 5 plays 6, etc. So the tie must be broken to determine who will face the third and sixth place teams, LSF and EDO respectively. As previously described, the USCF team tie-break system is used, the same system, by the way, which is applied at season's end should any teams be tied going into the playoffs after Round Twelve.

The calculations reveal that PRA has 20.75 tie-breaks as opposed to 11.50 for CCC'. On that basis PRA is seeded fourth and will play vs. LSF in the position round. CCC will face EDO. To do the math one must refer back to the game points scored in each round by those teams against their four respective opponents to date. Multiplied by the match points of those opponents (shown below) for each round yields the tie-breaks earned for that round. Adding the four rounds gives the total tie-breaks shown below.
