Time Out for the Teams

It is that time of year when we take a break from LIICL play to travel west to the chess Mecca known as Parsippany. Well its not really a chess Mecca, but it is the host of the World Amateur Team & US Team East tournament. The name is changed but this 37th edition still carries on under the able direction of Steve Doyle. It boasts close to 300 teams and more than 1,000 players over Presidents Day Weekend.

As in years past, there will be a strong LIICL contingent. Normally about 20 current and former LIICL alumni participate and this year should be no different. We wish good luck, good weather and good chess to those who are making the trip.

More Playoff Info

This year the playoffs will start as they did in previous seasons with team #8 playing team #9 in Round 1 to get into the ladder. The loser will be eliminated from further match play but those players will still be eligible for the Individual Swiss tournament. In Round 2 the winner of Round 1 plays the #1 ranked team, the #2 team plays #7, the #3 team plays #6 and team #4 plays #5. That follows the same paradigm as in previous years. This year the final two rounds will be different. In Round 3, the winner of the 2 vs. 7 match will play the winner of the 3 vs. 6 match. The winner of the 1 vs. 8/9 match will play the winner of the 4 vs. 5 match. What has changed is that the losers will not be eliminated but rather will enter another bracket. Then the loser of the 2 vs. 7 match will play the loser of the 3 vs. 6 match. The loser of the 1 vs. 8/9 match will play the loser of the 4 vs. 5 match. In the final round of match play, the winners will face each other in each bracket and the losers will play each other. That means that there will be four matches for Rounds 2, 3 & 4 of the playoffs. In previous
