Playoffs Start Tonight

Alumni C vs. Honeywell/KSF

Round 1 of the LIICL playoffs will feature the match-up of the eighth and ninth place teams for the right to advance into the quarterfinals. Based upon a reversal of colors when they met back in Round 1 of the regular season, Honeywell/KSF will have white on board 1. That match was taken by Honeywell/KSF and on that basis they enjoy tie-break odds in their playoff contest. If the match ends in a tie (2-2, 1.5-1.5, etc.), Honeywell/KSF will advance to meet regular season champion, LSF in the next round on April 13th. The losing team in Round 1 will be eliminated from further match play. The members of that team, as well as of any other team that does not sit for a playoff match, can participate in the Individual Swiss. The first round of the Individual Swiss also commences on March 23. The Swiss runs concurrently with the match playoffs and has its final and fifth round on May 18th.

The remaining quarterfinal matches scheduled for April 13th are already determined - EDO (W) vs. CCC (B), Alumni D (W) vs. PRA (B) and NGC (W) vs. Alumni E (B). The tie-break odds in those matches belong to CCC, PRA and NGC respectively. This year

Playoff Ratings in Effect

Page 4 contains a complete listing of those eligible to participate in this year's playoffs along with their new Playoff ratings. The ratings are reflective of results during rounds seven through twelve of the regular season.

All Captains should check to make sure that players sit in the correct board order which in some cases has changed from the regular season. Failure to do so may result in at least one forfeit and almost certain loss of any playoff match.

the losing teams as well as the winning teams in the quarterfinals will participate in match play throughout the playoffs. Instead of having their teams eliminated, the losers will enter a consolation bracket. In this way, all teams will eventually have a unique placing determined by over-the-board results rather than tie-breaks. It will also greatly limit the number of players who need to be paired for the Swiss. That will reduce noise and confusion in the playing hall.

Check your calendars and set aside Saturday, March 24th to log on to the ICC website. That is the day that USAT East champs Beavis and Butt-Vinnik will vie for the National team championship against the winners of the West, South and Mid-West editions of this tournament.

As was reported in the previous newsletter, the representative champions from the East include Nick Panico, James Critelli and Alan Kantor. All are currently LIICL members or are alumni.

The format for this is an elimination where each team plays a semifinal match via the Internet. The two winning teams then will meet for the championship. Consult with ICC for the exact time. You can log on to:

in order to set up an account. You will need to be an ICC member to participate in play or to watch such events. However you can sign-up for a free 7-day trial. If you do not care to continue after that period, it costs you nothing. We wish our fellow chessmates good luck and good chess!

Playoff Ratings are published above. These new ratings apply for determination of each team's board order for the post-season. If a player remains unrated, that player should be placed so that the relative rating position from the regular season does not change in relation to that player's teammates. If two players on the same team have identical ratings, they may be seated in the order of their captain's discretion. However, once that order is established, it cannot be changed. The new ratings will also be used to determine pairings for the Individual Swiss Tournament which runs concurrently with the team playoffs. Normal Swiss pairings will apply for players not participating in a team match with the exception that teammates will be restricted from facing each other in the first three rounds.

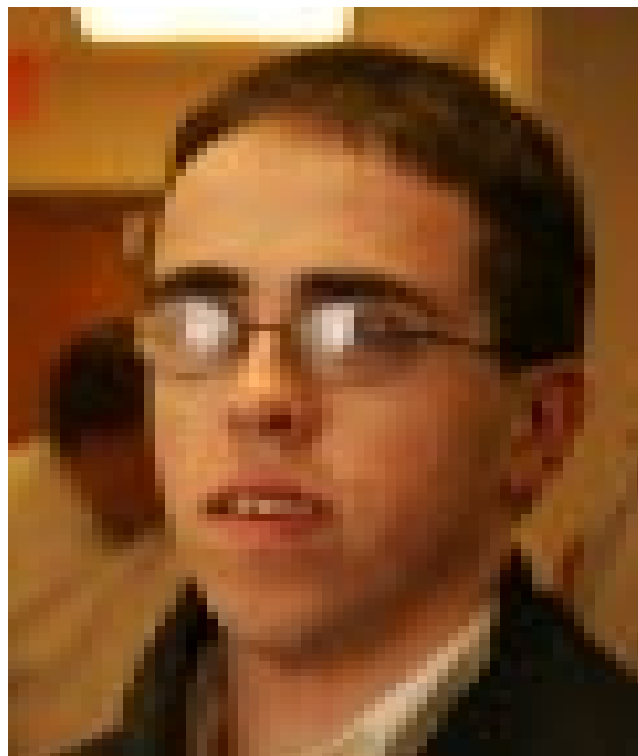

Olympiad XVII Qualifier

Submit Your Best Game!

The USA team participating in the qualifying round of the XVII Correspondence Chess Olympiad is in the thick of the battle with three-quarters of the games having reached conclusion. The top two teams of the ten in Section III will advance to the finals. Presently Switzerland is in first place with +9 and a scoring percentage of 62.5%. The USA team (which includes LIICL members Keith Rodriguez and Bob Rizzo) is in second +9, 60.7%. Scarcely behind is England at +8, 60.5%. The only other team with a chance to finish first or second is Slovakia +7, 58.5%.

The pre-tournament favorites were Switzerland and England with each team rated at 2527. Slovakia was next at 2489 while the USA was fourth at 2448. An analysis of the games remaining reveals that the USA has a legitimate shot at beating out both England and Slovakia for second. Further developments will be reported as the tournament winds down.

The following game from this tournament is the contest between Bob Rizzo and an English Senior International Master rated

2539. Black infiltrates Bob's back ranks with his Queen but Bob just manages to find a way to hold his position together and earn the draw.

You can send in the games without annotations but then you risk that the evaluation committee may miss the point! Your entry must include in the title whether it is being submitted for Best Game, Best Combination or Both. The games will then be viewable on the website. Just click on the "LIICL Games" link and you will be brought to the games viewer that has been set up by Jim Dwulit. Any game played under the auspices of LIICL play is eligible for either of these Ronnie Awards. That includes all regular season games, non-scheduled, rated games played during the season, all playoff games and all Individual Tournament games through Round 5. The deadline for submitting is Midnight, May 20th. So there is still time for to create, annotate and submit that brilliancy.

Complete Bracketology

As promised in a prior newsletter, we have attempted to clear up the complexities of the amended LIICL playoff system. As the brackets on this page shows, each match to be played has been assigned a letter. In round 1, match "P" will pit the eighth and ninth place finishers in the play-in contest to enter the quarterfinals. The winner advances to match "A" and the loser is now free to enter the Individual Tournament which is held concurrently with the playoff rounds. In round 2 the four quarterfinal ("A", "B", "C" and "D") matches will be held. The four winners advance to the semis in matches "E" and "F". The four losing teams will play in the bottom brackets shows as matches "H" and "I". In the semifinals, round 3, the winners of "E" and "F" will advance to match "G", for the Championship. The losers will then play each other in match "J" for third place overall. The winners of matches "H" and "I" will face each other in match "K" on finals night (round 4) with the winner taking fifth place. The losers of matches "H" and "I" will play in match "L" for seventh place. As always, those players who are alternates for their teams and are not participating in the team matches, may sign up for the Individual Swiss Tournament. All games in match play will double as Individual contest games. Round 5 is the Individual Swiss final round and all players who show will be paired per Swiss tournament rules.
