Entry Fees Now Overdue

The dues for this season are \$120 per team. Each team was responsible to remit payment by November 13th. Teams that are delinquent now risk forfeiting their matches.

World Cup Update

The FIDE World Chess Cup is currently underway. From the original field of 132 players only 8 are left, 3 Russians, 2 Azerbaijanians, 2 Ukrainians and an Israeli. The tournament is being held in Khanty-Mansiysk, Russia. It started on November 20th and will run through December 15th.

All of the American starters including past Cup champion Gata Kamsky were eliminated. After the first game of the fifth round Malakhov leads Svidler and Karjakin leads Mamedyarov each by a 1-0 score. The other two quarter finals are tied at 1/2 apiece: Ponamariov vs. Gashimov and Gelfand vs. Jakovenko.

Missing Medallions

The Medallions that were to be affixed to the Ronnies last year have arrived. They will be distributed to those teams/captains for which they were back-ordered. See Bob Rizzo for distribution.

Protest Hearing Postponed

The Executive Board of the LIICL will meet at a future date to hear the protest filed by the Borders Barbarians team. The protest centers around the second round contest between Darius Pour of the BBs and Rich Viale of ClearCut Computing. All team captains and officers are requested to attend. The meeting which was originally scheduled for November 13 was not held because the Plaintiffs, BBs, arrived 25 minutes late for the meeting, not leaving ample time for discussion prior to the scheduled 6:50 PM start of Round 5 play.

Rerating after Round 7

After completion of the Round 7 matches on January 8, 2010, the current regular season will have reached its midpoint. Mid-Season Ratings will be issued which will then be in effect up until the playoffs. Board playing order in the second-half could be affected by the changes resulting from the first-half season results.
